*Denise Burry is the mother of eight children, two of whom were internationally adopted. About seven years ago, she founded the Forward Paths Foundation to serve at-risk youth who have aged out of foster care. Currently, she serves as the executive director of that foundation and chairs the Salvation Army's Senior Housing and Homelessness Committee for Lake and Sumter County. She has received many awards for her community service, including the Mayor's Award by the City of Leesburg, the Humanitarian Award by the Leesburg Chamber of Commerce, the Leesburg Partnership's Community Service Award, and the Anna H. Settles Leadership Award at the Altrusa International Convention.*
