What Makes Our Criminal Justice System So Unjust?

President of the Lake County Voices of Reason

Cassandra is a recent graduate of the Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (FAMU) College of Law and hopes to become a civil rights attorney. She holds a Masters of Public Health degree from Kaplan University and a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Central Florida. After serving as President of the FAMU Law Chapter of the ACLU, she became the President of the Central Florida Chapter of the ACLU.

Ms. Brown, as a member of the Lake County Soil and Water Conservation District Board, is the only Black Lake County elected official. She currently sits on the Community Legal Services of Mid-Florida Board, serves on the League of Women Voters Juvenile Justice Committee, and is co-founder of a grassroots voting initiative, 2020 All About the Ballots. As President of the Lake County Voices of Reason, she engaged in a two-year battle against the relocation of a confederate statue to Lake County. Ms. Brown has four amazing children who often help her at protests and voting events.
